

## Call for submission of applications for an endowment grant

The Endowment Fund Praha ve filmu Prague Film Fund is announcing a call for submission of applications for an endowment grant for projects, the subject of which is a film or series in which the City of Prague is depicted as the City of Prague and which is intended for international distribution in cinemas, via television broadcasting, television rebroadcasting or video-on-demand services.

Grant proceedings shall be governed by both the Statutes of the Endowment Fund adopted by the Administrative Board on 21 December 2017 and the Conditions for provision of endowment grants which were adopted by the Administrative Board on September, 24 2019.

Objective of support	Support for positive presentation of the City of Prague abroad via film and television.  Attracting film and television projects with marketing potential and their utilisation for the promotion of the City of Prague.  Profiling of the City of Prague as a "film friendly" destination that is aware of the direct benefits and knock-on effect of audiovisual production.
Type of project	The Endowment Fund provides endowment grants for the following types of projects:  a) feature, documentary and animated films b) feature, documentary and animated series or episodes of a series  An application may only be submitted for a project, on which filming began or will begin between 1 July 2019 – 30 June 2020.  Start of filming shall be understood to mean principal photography for the film or series/series episode. Preliminary filming, tests, filming of trailers or teasers, filming for the purposes of casting or scouting etc. shall not be regarded as start of filming for these purposes.  The City of Prague is depicted in the audiovisual work as the City of Prague. The audiovisual work must be intended for international distribution in cinemas, via television broadcasting, television rebroadcasting or video-on-demand services.
Criteria for evaluation of applications	<ol> <li>Marketing potential of the project (from the point of view of tourism)</li> <li>Territory, form and scope of distribution</li> <li>Significance of the City of Prague in the work</li> <li>Manner in which the City of Prague is depicted in the work</li> <li>Significance of Prague motifs and specific filming locations (tourist, marketing, cultural, historical and architectural)</li> <li>Usability of the proposal for presentation of the City of Prague within the media campaign/activities relating to the work</li> </ol>

Number of planned filming days at locations in Prague</li> <li>The applicant shall be a legal person with their registered office or place of business within the territory of the Czech Republic and which is</li> <li>a) on the basis of contractual arrangement, commissioned by a producer with their registered office outside of the Czech Republic with submission of an application for an endowment grant</li> <li>b) a co-producer of the project being applied for, where at least one of the other co-producers of the project has a registered office outside of the Czech Republic</li> </ul>
Deadline for submission of applications	1 – 25 October 2019
De minimis regime	Per De minimis support is public support of a small scale – its level does not affect trade between EU member states or undermine or threaten economic competition.  Total support provided in the de minimis regime to one entity must not exceed the limit of EUR 200,000 over the decisive period (i.e. three consecutive accounting periods determined by the recipient of support in accordance with the Act on Accounting. This always concerns the current period and the two preceding periods).

Language of the	Applications shall be submitted in Czech or Slovak.
application and appendices	The synopsis and screenplay must, other than in a Czech/Slovak version, also be provided in English if such a synopsis or screenplay exists.
	The following documents may be provided only in English:  - service contract (copy)  - co-production contract/s (copy/copies)  - authorisation to submit the application if the applicant is a legal person which has been authorised on a contractual basis by a producer with its registered office outside of the Czech Republic to submit an application for an endowment grant (copy)  - documents relating to the provision of foreign distribution
Delivery of the application	Entities for which a data box is established by law shall only submit applications via the data box. Other entities shall submit applications via a provider of postal services. The date of sending the data message or handover for postal consignment shall be decisive for the receipt and acceptance of applications.

Other information	One applicant may submit several applications for one set of grant proceedings.
	There is no legal entitlement to provision of an endowment grant.
	No appeal is possible against the decision of the Administrative Board.
	The Endowment Fund is entitled to cancel grant proceedings or to not award any endowment grant.
	The endowment grant will be subject to billing and final report.
Schedule	The Administrative Board will make its decision on applications within three months of their submission.
	The endowment grant will be paid out in full after submission of Final project report by the recipient of the endowment grant as per the date of completion, its inspection by the Endowment Fund, test viewing of the work by members of the Administrative Board and provision of a document proving commencement of distribution of the work outside of the Czech Republic.
